### **Help Plan for the Future of Your Community!**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Redwood City has begun the development of a new five (5) year Consolidated plan for 2010-2015. The Consolidated Plan is required as a condition of the City receiving federal funds for housing and community development programs. The Plan is a community's unified vision for how local needs will be addressed over the five year plan with federal funds to be received annually during the Plan period.

The City of Redwood City receives federal funding for affordable housing, home rehabilitation, homeless services, public facilities improvements and to support social services programs.

A major requirement of the Plan is citizen consultation and participation in the needs assessment and strategic planning processes. The City intends to consult with a number of persons, organizations, agencies and public offices to gain a comprehensive understanding of the needs and gaps in the delivery of services in Redwood City with particular emphasis on the needs of low income, minorities and special needs populations. The City will hold consultations to receive citizen input on the needs of our residents and the priorities for funding for the 2009-2010 program year. Other focus groups and public meetings will be conducted over the next few months to assure that citizen input is inclusive from a wider range of stakeholders.

We want to hear from you what types of activities are important to you, where these activities should take place, and what are the needs you have.

Your input is part of the process to create the City's 2010-2015 Consolidated Plan for the use of funds received from the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This includes Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and Home Investment Partnerships (HOME) funds.
